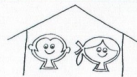
Mrs Arnold is taking leave for all of Term 4.

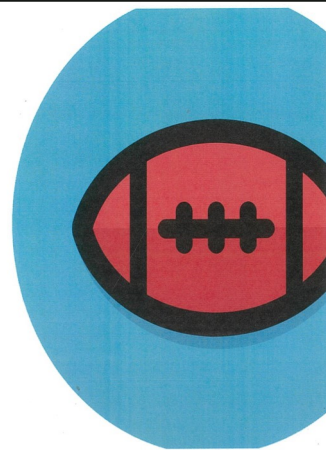
