## Race Around Aus

During term 2 Berrigan Public School will be participating in the Race Around Australia challenge along with many other schools around the country. The aim of this challenge is to be 'more active, more often'. Emphasis will be placed on encouraging regular participation in physical activity as part of the school day.

RAA is built on the SAAFE principles for physical education

Supportive - teachers are supported to implement physical activity opportunities and students are supported to engage in PA through engaging activities and links to curriculum.

Active - activities should be varied, moderate-vigorous intensity and include all students.

Autonomous - using our 'design your own workout' cards to encourage students choice and autonomy.

Fair - following our guidelines ensures a level playing field and fairness for all involved in the program.

Enjoyable - participants will want to take part in activities they find enjoyable.

Students will participate in a variety of class and whole school activities throughout the term, including running, which will then be converted to actual kilometres run as we strive to get our team as far around Australia as we can!
