This program of support for students, families and teachers is a Murrumbidgee Health initiative - an early intervention mental health program for children K-Year 2 and their parents/carers. Social and emotional difficulties are identified. Teachers will be trained to deliver the FRIENDS program to help children better manage their emotions, social interactions and behaviour. By working together we can create positive changes for children.

Information and surveys were sent home late last year for all students in K, Year 1 and Year 2 in 2022. If you misplaced it or disregarded it and now wish to be involved please let me know. We hope to implement the program in Term 2 when we have a clearer picture of what the needs are.


